



- **Under eave course** Fix a course of traditional eave tiles Ref: 501.13. (Hidden in this illustration).
- Course 1 Fix a tile and half tile Ref: 501.95 to start the first tiled course. Then alternately fix a Neo Plain Tile Ref: 333.00 and a St Foy Plain Tile Ref: 501.00 along the roof as the first course of tiles.
- Course 2 Start with 2 St Foy Plain Tiles Ref: 501.00 followed by Neo Plain Tiles Ref: 333.00 along the roof. Finish this course of Neo Plain tiles with two St Foy Plain Tiles Ref: 501.00.
- Course 3 Firstly fix a tile and half Ref: 501.95
 followed by Neo Plain Tiles Ref: 333.00 along the roof. Finish this course of Neo Plain tiles with a tile and half.
- Course 4 Repeat Course 2. Continue up the roof in this fashion.
- **Final Course** In between each Neo plain tile fix Top Tile Ref: 333.13.






Dry Fix for Non-Interlocking Ridge/Hips

Dry Vent ridge and hip systems are available. The NHBC now Non-Interlocking Kit Contents require that all ridges and hips are mechanically fixed even if a mortar bedded finish is chosen.

Non-Interlocking Kit Contents

- Ventilated ridge/hip roll (6m x 300mm)
- 2 Universal ridge union 3 100mm Fixing screws
- Self sealing clamping plate
 5 Truss batten fixing straps





Ventilation Options

Roof Ventilation should comply with building regulations and the control of condensation on buildings outlined in BS5250:2011 and Approved Document C2:2004 (amended 2010).

The level of ventilation depends firstly on the roof design, cold or warm roof construction, the type of membrane being used vapour permeable/breathable or impermeable underlays, roof pitches above or below 35° or roof spans that exceed 10 metres.

As a guide for most situations ventilation should be introduced at eaves or low level of 10,000 or 25,000 mm²/m and 5,000mm²/m at ridge or high level.




uPVC Inline tile vents for bathroom/kitchen extraction and soil vent terminals are available in complimentary colours to match Neo Plain tiles

Most dry vent ridge systems are designed to provide the required amount of ventilation at high level. If a dry vent ridge system is used tile vents would not be required.


